

Update on Energy Code TAG Activities – 2012 01 18

1. The Energy Code TAG continues to make progress in its effort to mark up the 2012 IECC to make it more or less equivalent to the 2009 Washington State Energy Code. The intent is to create a baseline for making proposals for the 2012 State Energy Code. The process has been completed for the Residential Provisions of the IECC. The TAG is now moving on to the Commercial Provisions.
2. The current versions of the mark-ups for the Residential and Commercial Provisions of the IECC are on the SBCC website. From the home page, click on 'TAGs', then 'Energy Code TAG', then look under "DRAFT 2012 IECC/WSEC Resource Documents" for the links.
3. In light of the pre-requisite task this code cycle of transitioning the 2009 State Energy Code to the IECC, the Building Code Council has extended the deadline for proposals for the 2012 Energy Code from March 1, 2012 to *March 15, 2012*.
4. The next meeting of the Energy Code TAG is Thursday, January 26. **This meeting will be almost entirely dedicated to the lighting and electrical portions of the IECC Commercial Provisions.** The agenda for the meeting has been sent as a separate attachment, and is also available at the State Building Code website.
