Labor and Industries – Not Present

City of Seattle - John Saldana

- Seattle is posting electrical inspector job openings.
- Plan review training class had 60 people attend. Seattle may host a second class.
- Seattle is working on the new permitting database. Implementation is targeted for April 9th.
- Eaton would like to discuss with SDCI about what products listed as a fuse holder vs fuse connector. There is confusion about what products can be used under what applications and what UL ratings they need. Al Hewitt to follow up with SDCI.
- Seattle may require EV charging stations to be actually installed. Charging stations will need to be taken at 125% if a load management system is not installed.

PSE – Andrew Pultorak

- New incentives are active. There are large incentives on retro and new construction for fixtures with both daylight and occupancy sensors. This method of control is referred to as a LLC Fixture.
- PSE's case studies have shown these fixtures drastically reduce lighting energy consumption.

Snohomish PUD - Rob Marks

- New construction lighting rebates are now active. Design needs to meet 35% better than code threshold.
- There are active HVAC rebates. Bonuses up to 25%.
- There are plans for a building recommissioning pilot program.

- There hasn't been any activity. The Building Code Council is currently updating their information. Energy Code Tag is waiting for other Code Committees to be ready to issue their proposals.
- A form will be available soon to submit proposals for the next iteration of the Energy Code.
