Snohomish PUD Arlington Microgrid & Community Solar Project

17601 59th Avenue NE, Arlington

Driving Directions:

- Northbound Interstate-5 (I-5) from downtown Seattle to Snohomish PUD Arlington Microgrid (approximately 40 miles)
- Take Exit 206 toward WA-531 E/172nd Street NE/Smokey Point
- Keep right in the fork, and merge onto WA-531 E/172nd Street NE
 - Travel east on HWY 531 through the initial stop-light intersections for 1.7 miles. This road will narrow to one lane eastbound
- Turn left on 59th Ave NE (3 leg intersection)
- While traveling north on 59th Avenue NE, you will see Arlington Municipal Airport on your left side.
- Turn right on 180th Street NE
 - 180th Street NE is immediate right hand turn <u>after</u> Skookum Brewery; be sure to watch for this specific landmark
 - Use the PUD-provided map at this point. This is where it can be tricky to locate us.
- On 180th Street NE, you will see modest manufacturing development on both sides of the single lane road. Watch for a PUD Pole Yard sign on the left side of road, you are getting close!
- <u>Take first right after you see a small marine craft parts & storage site.</u> Heading south through the Snohomish PUD gate
- The Clean Energy Center and Microgrid Site will be visible as you drive a short distance past the PUD Pole Yard.

Notes:

- As we've mentioned, street frontage to our property is relatively undeveloped. The frontage at **17601 59th Avenue NE, Arlington** is the future home of SnoPUD North County Office with planned opening in 2023.
- As per instructions, when you take 180th Street NE it takes you to the back side of the PUD's property.
- The map that I've attached below shows the entire property undeveloped, but don't be concerned as the property has seen its fair share of construction with the community solar and microgrid project, among other developments.
